The following language may assist you and your attorney in creating or revising your Will.

1. Bequest of Cash for General Purposes

"I bequeath the sum of \$ _____ to _____ United Methodist Church, which has a federal tax identification number of _____, and a physical address of _____, for the church's general use and purposes."

2. Bequest of Cash for a Specific Purpose

"I bequeath the sum of \$ _____ to _____ United Methodist Church, which has a federal tax identification number of _____, and a physical address of _____, for the church's e.g., permanent endowment."

3. Bequest of Specific Assets for General Purposes

"I bequeath the following described property to _____ United Methodist Church, which has a federal tax identification number of _____, and a physical address of _____: e.g., stocks, saving bonds, real estate, for the church's general use and purposes."

4. Bequest of Specific Assets for a Specific Purpose

"I bequeath the following described property to _____ United Methodist Church, which has a federal tax identification number of _____, and a physical address of _____: e.g., stocks, savings bond, real estate, for the church's e.g., permanent endowment."

5. Bequest of Residuary

"All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both personal and real, I give to _____ United Methodist Church, which has a federal tax identification number of _____, and a physical address of _____, for the church's general use and purposes or for the church's permanent endowment."

6. Bequest of a Percentage of Your Estate

7. Contingent Bequest of a Percentage of Your Estate
